RULE Gallery is pleased to present an exhibition of new work by artist **Joseph Coniff** entitled **(in parentheses)**. Pulled from the artist's current series, *Delineation*, the exhibition features painting, sculpture and works on paper utilizing a wide spectrum of materials and techniques from traditional to digital. With *Delineation*, Coniff explores his interest in the metaphysical nature of objects and the role and significance material things have within day-to-day life. These abridged and abstracted works act as didactic timelines, concentrating on the understanding and relationship one has with the creation and existence of objects.

**(in parentheses)** will be on view at RULE Gallery, 3254 Walnut St, Denver CO, 80205 and will run from July 24, 2014 to September 6, 2014. The public reception is scheduled for Thursday, July 25, 2014 from 6 to 9pm. The gallery is open Tuesday – Saturday, 12-6p, with hours extended to 9pm on First Friday and by appointment.

Joseph Coniff earned his Bachelor of Fine Arts at the Rocky Mountain College of Art and Design in 2011 and is currently an MFA candidate at the University of Delaware. Coniff will be included in *New American Paintings*, No. 114, West Issue and the forthcoming 100 Best Annual issue of *Creative Quarterly*. He was listed as one of CBS Denver's 2012 Top Up and Coming Artists and was awarded Denver Westword's 2012 Best Emerging Artist Show for his 2011 exhibition *This Is What It's Like* at Rule Gallery.

**RULE Gallery** reopened in June of 2014 with a permanent space located at 3254 Walnut St in Denver. The gallery identifies and supports contemporary abstract and conceptual artists working in all mediums. RULE has been bringing national art to Denver since 1987 through representation of prominent artists from around the country, while supporting the Denver art scene by promoting leading regional artists.
