Shoshannah White (b. 1970, New York) is an American interdisciplinary, photo-based artist who lives and works in Roswell, New Mexico. She received her BFA in Photography from the Savannah College of Art and Design. Her work has been exhibited in the United States, Canada, and Europe, with solo and featured exhibitions at museums and contemporary art spaces including the University of New England, the Maine Maritime Museum, the New Art Center, the Center for Maine Contemporary Art, Bates College Museum of Art and Dickinson College with an upcoming solo exhibition at the University of Delaware. Her work has been included in group exhibitions internationally, with venues ranging from the Roswell Museum to institutions in Greece and Italy. Her work is held in museum and private collections including Bates College Museum of Art, Bowdoin College Museum of Art, Dickinson College Museum of Art, and the Glickman-Lauder Collection at the Portland Museum of Art. White is a 2025 Guggenheim Fellow in Photography.

Artist Statement

Her photographic work often spans painting, sculpture and public art installation. Shoshannah's research-based, non-linear approach has led her to various sites to create projects focused on natural phenomena and ecological systems. Works exist as objects for exhibition, editorial content and installation pieces.
